Sadia Ricke joined the Bank in February 2023 as Group Chief Risk Officer, also appointed as a director of the Court of SC Bank. Sadia is a member of the Standard Chartered Bank, Group Management Team and is responsible for the development of group risk processes, to encourage development of an appropriate risk culture and discipline.

Career

Sadia has a broad range of financial and risk experience and a thorough understanding of our footprint markets. She joined the Bank from Société Générale, where she started in 1994 in the Financial Institutions Credit department. Sadia gained more than 13 years of structured finance experience in the Natural Resources and Energy Finance division where she was Co-Deputy Head, a position she held until 2010 before moving to become Head of Credit Risk for SG CIB in Paris. In 2015 Sadia relocated to Hong Kong to take on the role of Head of Global Finance for Asia Pacific. She was appointed Group Country Head and Head of Coverage and Investment Banking for the UK in 2017. Sadia became Deputy Chief Risk Officer in 2019 and subsequently, in 2021, became the Group Chief Risk Officer.

Sadia graduated from HEC Paris (Ecole des Hautes Etudes Commerciales).

In February 2023 Sadia became a member of the International Financial Risk Institute (IFRI) Foundation.
